- "It won't really matter in the grand scheme of things"



We did not show this to overwhelm you, we wanted you to be aware of this problem. Now that you know this truth, what do we do about it? No single person can fix this, but we can collectively make a difference, it starts with you.

Everything is connected. Food is connected to everything – air, water, soil, chemicals, volcanoes on the other side of the world, plastic floating in a ocean, eaten by a fish which is eaten by a bigger fish eaten by you and now poisoning you. Or put in the fertilizer that is put in your potting soil that goes in your vegetable garden eaten by you. Just because it is on the other side of the planet, on another continent, in another country, another state, some other county, not your neighborhood – it does affect you, it will affect you and you cannot ignore it. Do not let this be permission to take on the weight of the world or to fear, you just need to acknowledge that your actions do impact the whole and the whole is important. Stewardship goes far beyond what you physically touch and see, it compounds dynamically over the course of time so that now there is an island of plastic in the middle of nowhere ocean. A place you would think should be the most pristine and untouched.

Even hidden sin – dumping garbage in the ocean – will come to light. Burying trash will not make it go away either. It has to be dealt with or it will poison the ground and make you sick. Deal with everything for if you do not, it will fester, rot, break down into sharp tiny poisonous pieces that will spread from you to others. The earth is not broken yet, it can be fixed but you must start now, not tomorrow, not later, now. Choose to honor God in stewardship in taking care of the planet, time, resources and talents He has given us. Choose you this day who you will serve, God? or convenience, greed and selfish carelessness. It isn't their problem or a problem for someone else to fix - it is our problem.

Imagine standing before your Heavenly Father who has every deed done, every word spoken, every thought you have entertained recorded and then seeing your own personal landfill, filled with all the garbage you have produced. Things you have trashed, tossed out the window of a car, dropped as you walked, didn't recycle, poured out on the ground or buried in the back yard. If you could see it all in one pile from a lifetime of use, I am sure you will agree with me that one person can make a difference – even if it is just before your **Heavenly Father.**

You have the ability to change — are you willing? One person is not much but one person can change others. You are responsible for you and that is all you can control right now so do the best you can with what you know, have learned and have access to.

Now that we understand more about stewardship, what will we do about it? It is going to require time, energy, thought and deliberate action. It may take you out of your comfort zone.


